"The First Annual CRNG Smallbore Rifle Championship"

This event will consist of a series of 5 monthly shoots of which each participant's aggregate of their 4 best scores would be used to determine the Club Champion and Class winners. Each participant could be absent for one shoot, or throw out one of their 5 scores

Equipment:

This shoot will be limited to any caliber Rimfire Rifle, not to exceed .22 caliber. Any type of rifle will be allowed with any type of action and sights, except lasers. Any capacity magazine will be permitted but a maximum of 10 rounds will be allowed in the magazine for each shooting position. Any type of commercial manufactured ammunition will be allowed.

Course of Fire:

- ◆ Each participant will shoot a relay of 10 shots per target in three positions; Standing, Sitting at the Bench, and Kneeling, at 50 yards and 100 yards, a total of 60 shots for one monthly shoot.
- ♦ Each shooter will have 5 minutes to complete their 10 shots at each position and 3 minutes to change position and reload
- The targets will be official NRA TQ3 50yd and TQ4 100yd Smallbore targets.
- ♦ All shooting will be done offhand with no aids other than a sling. When shooting from the bench, resting one elbow on the bench will be permissible.
- ♦ Shooters are permitted to have a spotter call their shots, or may spot for themselves. (A note on the shooting positions: I am proposing Sitting at the Bench as one position to allow those shooters who are not very competent at shooting from the other positions to be competitive. If I can find a way to accommodate it, I would like to change this to the Prone position.)

Scoring:

Shooters will score each other's targets. The event referee will decide all disputes. Any target with **MORE** than 10 hits will be scored using the **WORST** 10 hits on the target. Re-shoots for malfunctions will be allowed, but again the target will be scored using the **WORST** 10 hits on the target. Only one re-shoot per target will be allowed.

Each participant's scores for each monthly shoot would be recorded, aggregated and posted on the CRNG website. The total aggregate score for 4 shoots would determine the Club Champion and other Class winners.

Tie scores will be broken first by the number of X's scored, and if necessary a 5 shot shoot-off at 100 yards at one position TBD at the last scheduled shoot.

Prizes would be awarded for the highest scores in the following classes:

- High Overall Score "Club Champion"
- High Score Men

- High Score Ladies
- High Score Veteran (must be at least 55 years old at the start of the first shoot)
- High Score Senior Veteran (must be at least 65 years old at the start of the first shoot)
- High Score Super Senior Veteran (must be at least 75 years old at the start of the first shoot)
- High Score Junior (must be under 18 years old at the start of the first shoot)

If a participant has a birthday or a sex change during the five-month event that would put them in a different class, they will remain in the class in which they started.

The High Overall Winner (Club Champion) will not be eligible to win any other class prize.

I will be proposing an entrance fee of \$10, (Juniors \$5) per participant to cover the cost of targets and prizes. Any revenues realized in excess of expenses will be donated to the Junior Rifle League

I will be proposing the following dates for the shoots:

Saturday May 22

Saturday June 19

Saturday July 24

Saturday August 21

Saturday September 11

All shoots would be scheduled for 9:00AM until completion.
