Allan Parker, President of The Justice Foundation, is a former Professor of Law at St. Mary's University in San Antonio, Texas, where he taught Education Law and Civil Procedure. He was a Visiting Professor at the University of Texas, and studied International Human Rights at the International Human Rights Institute in Strasbourg, France. He taught International Human Rights at St. Mary's Institute on World Legal Problems in Innsbruck, Austria in 1992.

The Justice Foundation is currently representing both Norma McCorvey, formerly “Roe” of Roe v. Wade, and Sandra Cano, the “Doe” of Doe v. Bolton, in the effort to overturn the two landmark cases that brought legalized abortion on demand to America. “Both women are deeply concerned and have come to the conviction that abortion is not the answer for women who are in a vulnerable pregnancy,” says Allan Parker, President of the Justice Foundation.
