#### VOTES AND SURVEY QUESTIONS:

1. Vote on 2007 SB 77 (State of NH defunding of Planned Parenthood: killed)
2. Vote on 2007 HB 184 (repeal of parental notification: passed)
3. Vote on 2006 SB 343 (parental consent before pharmacists dispense emergency contraception to minors. Bill also contained pharmacist conscience clause: killed)
4. Survey: "If elected I will do whatever I can within the power of my office to restore the right to life for all innocent human beings from the moment of their conception."
5. Survey: Prohibiting abortion during third trimester OR VOTE on 2008 HB 1403 (relative to abortion when there is a reasonable expectation of viability)
6. Survey: Banning all Embryonic Stem Cell Research but allowing "adult" stem cell research OR VOTE 2006 HJR 20 resolution supporting stem cell research
