Pawtuckaway State Park is about 15 miles Northeast of Manchester – about 4 miles north of Raymond in Nottingham, NH. Exact directions are on-line at <http://www.nhrtl.org/picnic/2005> From the west, take I-93 to Route 101, Exit 5 (Raymond). From the east, take I-95 to Route 101, Exit 5. Upon taking Exit 5, head north on Route 107, past the McDonald's. Turn left at the Tee and then take a quick right onto Nottingham Road. Follow the NHRTL signs about 3 miles to Pawtuckaway State Park.
